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### All the best from Argentina

Two new products from Argentina impressed the Great Taste Awards judges this year who awarded a bronze to Ché Honey and silver to Dulce de Leche, both available through UK importers, Building Bridges Limited.

Ché is an Argentine organic honey from single estates and never blended or heated. Every harvest and each local area produces a distinctive type. For example, Prosopis Alba is harvested from a selected area of the uncultivated Gran Chaco Forest in northern Argentina. Its location, over 250 miles from the nearest city, means the honey is free from pollutants.

Dulce de Leche is the quintessential national spread made from the milk of cows that graze the Argentinian Pampas grasslands, cane sugar and a little vanilla. Low in fat, it is claimed to be the fastest growing ice-cream flavour and is used by many top name manufacturers. Great as a spread on toast, it also makes a delicious filler for pancakes and muffins and, with a low fat content, won't blow the diet. Too good to be true? The Argentines certainly don't think so.
